New Jersey Career Technical Education (CTE) Statistics At-A-Glance: Funding:

- Perkins Funds Received in FY10: \$26,071,027ⁱ
- Perkins Funds Received in FY11: \$22,509,427
- Percent change: -13.66%

CTE Student Outcomes Data:

- Almost all (99%) of CTE students in New Jersey completed high school on time.
- ➤ 94% of secondary CTE students in New Jersey were employed, in the military, or in postsecondary education or advanced training six months after graduation in 2009-2010.^{III}
- Most postsecondary CTE students (97%) met or exceeded technical skill proficiency levels.
- ➤ Almost all eligible postsecondary CTE students (99%) attained a certificate, credential, or degree in 2009-2010.

- Number of Secondary Students Enrolled in CTE in New Jersey in 2009-2010: 11,780^{iv}
- Number of Postsecondary Students Enrolled in CTE in New Jersey in 2009-2010: 63,705°

From today through 2018 in NJ:

- → Business Management and Administration will be the largest overall Career Cluster.
- → Information Technology will be the fastest growing Career Cluster.
- → 42% of all jobs in New Jersey will be found in Business Management and Administration, Marketing, Sales, and Services, and Hospitality and Tourism.
- → In NJ by 2018, there will be about425,000 jobs for those with certificates.
