## Pennsylvania Career Technical Education (CTE) Statistics At-A-Glance: Funding:

- Perkins Funds Received in FY10: \$49,131,116<sup>i</sup>
- Perkins Funds Received in FY11: \$42,836,625
- Percent change: -12.81%

#### **CTE Student Outcomes Data:**

- CTE students in Pennsylvania graduated from high school at a higher rate than the statewide rate in 2009-2010 (98% compared to 90%)<sup>ii</sup>
- ➤ The majority of secondary (88%) and postsecondary (88%) CTE students in Pennsylvania were employed, in the military, or in postsecondary education or advanced training six months after graduation in 2009-2010<sup>iii</sup>
- ➤ Almost all (98%) of secondary CTE students in Pennsylvania graduated high school on time<sup>iv</sup>

#### **CTE Enrollment Data:**

- Number of Secondary Students Enrolled in CTE: 91,543<sup>v</sup>
- Number of Postsecondary Students Enrolled in CTE: 76,553vi

# CTE: Preparing Pennsylvania's Students for Jobs of Today and Jobs of the Future

From today through 2018 in PA:

- → The Marketing, Sales, and Services Career Cluster will be the largest in PA.
- → Health Science will be the fastest growing, with jobs increasing by 17% by 2018.
- → 40% of all jobs in PA will be found in the Business Management and Administration, Marketing, Sales, and Services, and Hospitality and Tourism Career Clusters.
- → In PA by 2018, there will be about 630,000 jobs for those with certificates.
