Virginia Career Technical Education (CTE) Statistics At-A-Glance: CTE Funding:

- Perkins Funds Received in FY10: \$27,720,438ⁱ
- Perkins Funds Received in FY11: \$24,244,261
- ➤ Percent change: -12.54%

CTE Student Outcomes Data:

- Nearly all secondary CTE students in Virginia (98%) met or exceeded math and reading/language arts proficiency levels in 2009-2010.
- ➤ 99% of secondary CTE students in Virginia completed high school on time."
- Almost all (98%) of secondary CTE students in Virginia were employed, in the military, or in postsecondary education or advanced training six months after graduation in 2009-2010.

CTE Enrollment Data:

- ➤ Number of Secondary Students Enrolled in CTE in Virginia in 2009-2010: 244,430iv
- Number of Postsecondary Students Enrolled in CTE in Virginia in 2009-2010: 72,402^v

CTE: Preparing Virginia's Students for Jobs of Today and Jobs of the Future

From today through 2018 in VA:

- → The Marketing, Sales, and Services Career Cluster will be the largest Career Cluster.
- → Information Technology will be the fastest growing Career Cluster, increasing 38% by 2018.
- → Business Management and Administration will add the most jobs in Virginia through 2018.
- → 42% of all jobs in Virginia will be found in Marketing, Sales, and Services, Business Management and Administration, and Hospitality and Tourism.
- → In VA by 2018, there will be about 450,000 jobs for those with certificates.
