It is a huge honor and absolute pleasure to write a letter highlighting the Agriculture Academy and CTE pathways at Woodland High School. The Agriculture Academy was established prior to 1929, and since they continue to grow as a department meeting the needs of the industry while working hard to prepare the students for an abundance of choices post high school graduation. The Agricultural department constantly ensures they are current with the needs of the industry and boast numerous pathways including plant and soil science, veterinary science, power mechanics and horticulture.

Woodland is located in an agriculture community outside of Sacramento, California. There is a diverse population of students that we are privileged to serve. We currently have roughly 1400 students at Woodland High School with approximately 70% identified Latino/Hispanic, 20% Caucasian and the remaining 10% is blended diversity. In addition, we have approximately 68% of our students who are socio-economically disadvantaged and faces numerous barriers. It should be noted that the history of WHS is as rich as the soil that surrounds our school. Many of our students are children and grandchildren of former WHS graduates. There is a deep commitment in the entire community to preserve and prepare our agricultural world for student success. The Agriculture department has created such hope for our students, and it is an absolute pleasure that the entire school demographics are mirrored within their program. All students find success, in a supportive challenging way.

The team at Woodland High School are a pristine model of what it means to be a lifelong learner wanting to not only grow the department but ensure they are preparing the future ag leaders of tomorrow. They are constantly applying for grants, including the Agriculture Incentive Grant and insuring they partner with the industry to stay current. The advisor board with the support of the Yolo County Office of Education, industry leaders, community members, faculty and site administration they are constantly informed. They are extremely progressive and always wanting to move the bar higher for each student that is in their program.
